What is blood? Medically, it can be defined as a reddish fluid in the vascular system of human beings and other vertebrates, which is pumped by the heart through the arteries and veins, supplying tissues with nutrients, oxygen, etc, and removing waste products from all parts of the body. Thus, we can think of the blood spiritually as the unseen fluid in the life of a believer that circulates in the heart, soul and spirit, nourishing lives and removing all unwanted products.

There are two kinds of blood, in the bible. The blood of animal, that protected the Israelites in Egypt from being partakers of the assignment of the angel of destruction sent to torment the Egyptians, and the blood of Jesus that washes away our sins.

Exodus 12:13(NKJV) "Now the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you; and the plague shall not be on you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt."

The blood of Jesus was shed for us over 2000 years ago, on the cross of Calvary. This blood is very much available today with the same efficacy. Let us examine some characteristics of this blood:

- It is the blood of the only begotten son of God, Jesus Christ. Not just any blood, but the sinless blood of the Lamb, 2 Corinthians 5:2.
- The blood can heal all kinds of sicknesses and diseases, 1 Peter 2:24.
- The blood gives us redemption and for-

giveness of sins, Col 1:14.

- The blood delivers us from the power of darkness and bondage of the world, Col 1:13.
- The blood erases our past, gives us a clean report and future, Col 2:14.

Jesus uttered on the cross "it is finished". His head slumped to His chest, and the penalty for sin was satisfied. Before His death on the cross, we all stood guilty before God. We were condemned and without hope, but that changed after Jesus' blood was shed. That blood now speaks on our behalf.

For the blood to work for you, you need

to accept Jesus into your life as your personal Lord and Savior and become His friend. The power in the blood can only be real when you have an encounter with the owner of the blood. When you accept Him as your savior, your past will no longer exist for in Christ old things will pass away and everything will be come new, 2 Cor. 5 : 17 and there will be no condemnation for you, Rom. 8 : 1.

As soon as Jesus becomes the Lord and master of your life, you can start to plead the blood upon your situations and problems. The blood knows no limitations, barriers or boundaries. It reaches through the highest mountain, can flow through the lowest valley and can never lose its power.

You can enjoy the power in the blood today by speaking His word, for the blood of Jesus is constantly working in line with the word of God. If you do not know Jesus as your personal Lord and savior, you can speak the word today and begin to enjoy the power in the blood by praying this prayer with me:

Shall we pray? Lord Jesus, I receive you today into my life as my personal Lord and savior. Let your blood erase my past and give me a new life. Let me be a carrier of your power as I plead your blood every day.
